Pupils in Reception, year 1 and year 2 will be provided with a piece of fruit each day. They should not bring in anything else.

Pupils in years 3,4,5,6 may;

bring in £1 to buy a tuck card, each item is 25p(maximum two items).

OR

 bring in two plain biscuits eg rich tea, digestive **not** cookies, creams or chocolate OR a piece of fruit OR a buttered piece of bread (no topping).

Talking to teachers.

If you have a concern that you wish to raise with a teacher please phone the office and they will arrange an appointment for you. Please remember to bring a mask if you have an appointment in school.

Water bottles.

Please ensure that your child has a water bottle in school. They will be sent home every night for cleaning

Hand Sanitiser.

Please do not send your child to school with hand sanitiser. The children wash their hands according to a timetable and there is lots of hand-sanitiser in school. The reason for this is for the safety of the children. We would hate any of our younger children to accidently ingest hand-sanitiser that is accidently left around school—the alcohol content of some sanitisers could result in fatal injury. Thank you for your help in this matter.
