Our Values

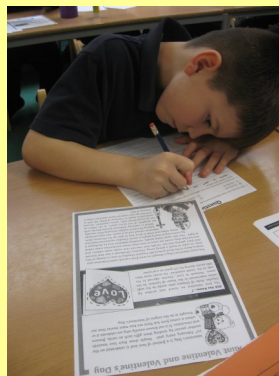
This week the children have been finding out why we have Valentine's day. We talked about values and how we show these during the special day.
