


Materials

We use different materials for different jobs based on their properties.

Bricks are used to build houses because they are strong, hard and **durable**.

Houses used to be built from wood. Why do you think we don't do this anymore?



Properties – a quality or characteristic of something.Durable – able to withstand wear, pressure, or damage; hard-wearing.



We use different materials for different jobs based on their **properties.**

Rubber is used for tyres on vehicles because rubber is strong, **flexible** and durable.

Why do you think tyres have to be flexible?



Definition Corner

Flexible – able to bend easily without breaking.


Durable – able to withstand wear, pressure, or damage; hard-wearing.
