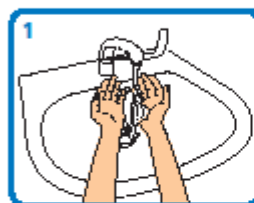

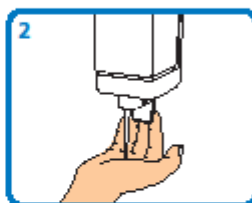
WASH YOUR HANDS MORE OFTEN FOR 20 SECONDS



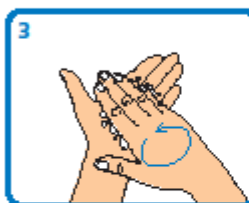
Hand-washing technique with soap and water



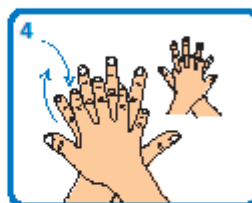
Wet hands

hand surfaces



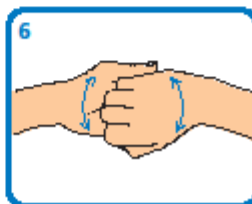
Rub hands palm

with fingers interlaced



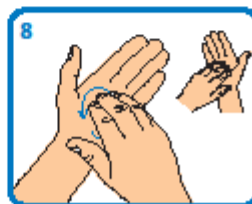
Rub palm to palm with

fingers interlocked



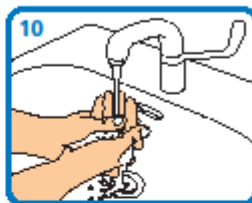
Rub each thumb clasped

rotational movement



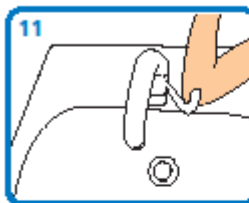
Rub tips of fingers in
