<p>Play speed trial on phonics play (press phase 3 and also phase 5)</p> <p>Go on the <u>internet</u> to ictgames.com</p> <p>Find the game <u>Little Bird Spelling (year 1)</u>.</p> <p>Click on a bird house and practise some words of your choice.</p>	<p>Take a look at the picture of the Easter bunny on the website/class homepages or VLE attachments.</p> <p>How would you describe her? Talk about your ideas and write some <u>words</u> or <u>sentences</u>.</p> <p>Don't forget to use finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.</p> <p><u>Top Tips</u> Join some sentences with and or because.</p> <p>Don't forget to sound out your words carefully.</p>	<p>Practise counting up to 100. You can use the 100 splat square on line to help if you like. https://www.primarygames.co.uk/</p> <p>Ask a grown up to say some numbers while you splat them.</p> <p>Choose a number (5-100) Roll a dice. What number did you roll?</p> <p>Can you write the addition number sentence (for e.g. $12+4=$ $30+5=$ $6+6=$) Ask a grown up for help to write it if you need to.</p>

Practise some of your year 1 common exception words. You might want to try pyramid</p>	<p>Read the story about How the Easter Bunny Saved Easter.</p> <p>What story would you make up about the Easter Bunny?</p> <p>Use today to think of some ideas with a grown up and talk your story through.</p>	<p>Play a game of number tennis (like we do in class). Start on different numbers and practise counting both forwards and back.</p> <p>Choose a number between 6 and 100. Roll a dice What number did you roll?</p> <p>Can you write the subtraction/take away number sentence (for e.g. $10-4$, $46-3$, $33-2$, $16-5$)</p> <p><u>Too tricky?</u></p>

<p>Ictgames.com: Find the game <u>The Dinosaur Eggs</u> and choose a list of words that you would like to read.</p> <p>Play Forest phonics on above website.</p>	<p>Today you can have a go at writing your own short story about the Easter Bunny.</p> <p><u>Too tricky?</u> Ask a grown up to help</p> <p>Write some words about the story.</p> <p>Write 3 sentences about the beginning, middle and end.</p>	<p>Practise counting in twos, fives and tens. Ask a grown up to say a number. Can you say the number that is 1 more/1 less?</p> <p>Ask your parent/carer to tip out their purse/wallet ☺. Can you put the coins in order of value? Collect some coins. Find different ways of making 5, 10 and 20p.</p>
<p>Practise your spellings and write them in a sentence.</p> <p>Play <u>Robot Reader</u> on phonics play. Choose the level that you'd like to try.</p>	<p>The following task is for today and tomorrow: (Grown-ups to help please)</p> <p>Use your computer or books to find facts about bunnies.</p> <p>Begin to make a book about them. You can print or draw pictures and write some facts if you can. See if you can add a contents page and a beautiful front cover</p>	<p>Practise counting up to 100. You can use the 100 splat square on line to help if you like. https://www.primarygames.co.uk/ Ask a grown up to say some numbers while you splat them. How many jumps/claps/hops can you do it in a minute? Use a clock and experiment with finding o'clock, half past and quarter past times. How do these times look on a digital clock? Use the interactive clock tool to help you too. https://www.visnos.com/demos/clock</p>
<p>Practise your sounds on Speed trial flash cards (phonicsplay).</p>		<p>Today you might like to do a maths problem solving investigation: nrich.maths.org/143</p>
