CALLING ALL YOUNG VOICES PARENTS!

Young Voices made the difficult decision to postpone their January concerts until the Spring/Summer due to the current rise in risk of Covid. This is really disappointing, but obviously the decision has been made with everyone's best interests at heart. All ticket, t-shirt and coach payments will be held ready for the new concert date which we will confirm next week. Apologies as I know that this change will cause disruption to many of you who hoped to attend the original concert date next week.

Census Day Free School Meals

As you are aware all of the children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal every day. What you won't be aware of is that the school is not paid for all of these meals unless your child has a meal on census day! The school is paid for meals based on the average number of children having school meals on these days - this means that if 50 children have a meal on census days but 100 children have meals on the other days we only receive the money for 50 of the children taking the meals each day! This has cost our school approximately £10,000 this year (more than a teaching assistant costs us.) Think how much equipment we could have also bought with that money! The next census day is on Thursday 20th January 2022. On that day we will be booking every child a meal who is entitled to one and offer it to your child. If you are worried that your child will not eat the lunch please feel free to send a packed lunch as well. If they don't eat their lunch we will offer them the packed lunch - if they do they can take their lunch home for tea! On Census day the choice for dinner will be the option for Friday of Fish Fingers and Chips or Pinwheels. Friday will be the option for Thursday which will be International day (sweet &

GroupCall At times we send messages in this way so please ensure you read them. If you aren't receiving messages please contact the office.


Contact details If you change your phone number, address or email please contact the office so we can update our records.



> LIKEE (formally known as LIKE) is a free video creation and editing app similar to TikTok. It has a global community of over 200 million users who can create any type of video, add their own special effects and then upload and share them with the world. The app is largely used to create short music videos which users can star in and edit anyway they want using the "Magic Video Maker." Users share their videos on the platform as well as having the option to share across other social media outlets such as Facebook and Instagram. Due to the suggestive content that is available on the app, it has a recommended age of 16+, although the app store rate it as 17+.

All user profiles on LIKEE are public whin means that every video that is uploaded can be viewed by anyone. This is a priva setting which can't be changed. In addit on creating an account, anybody who vi your child's video can also download, sa and share them, albeit this is a feature w can be turned off. Nonetheless, this plaa your child's privacy at risk given they ca control who is viewing their videos and potentially sharing them elsewhere.
