Our attendance was not as strong this week, with a whole school total of 96.7 %. Hopefully we can get this back up again after the Easter Holidays.


However, our attendance for the whole term has been an outstanding 98.07 %. Wow! We are so proud of everyone's commitment in getting the children back into school and learning again.
