Dear Parents,

This week I have been updating my safeguarding training and our training on behaviour and how we deal with challenges. Today I was speaking to children about how we deal with mistakes children make. It was really great to hear the children affirm that they understand that they need to speak to us when something goes wrong and that they know that we always act and deal with issues.

It was fantastic to hear the children talk to me about their understanding of the challenges some of their friends face and their understanding of calm down time. They told me that they won't always know how a problem is dealt with but they know it will be. I am so proud of the understanding our pupils have towards other pupils and how pupils feel able to be open about challenges they face, knowing that their friends will support them through the good times and the bad.

The trainers visiting our school this week were so impressed with the way the children behaved and the good manners they show. They commented on how lovely it was to see so many parents hugging and kissing their children as they said goodbye to them. Sadly, they said, it is not something they always see in other schools they visit.

Although some covid rules are lifted this week the rules on the car park will remain the same with face masks and social distancing please. Hopefully come June we will be able to reduce all of the rules. Many thanks for your continued support.
