Dear Parents,

Covid 19

If your child has a persistent cough, temperature or has lost their sense of taste or smell they should self isolate for 14 days at home or stay off school until they have had a negative test.

Please inform school if anyone in your household bubble has a positive test.

Children with normal cold symtoms are able to come to school each day.
