

How to pack an explorer's backpack

You will need:

- a large rucksack
- a small tent
- a sharp ice axe
- a helpful first aid kit
- a compass
- binoculars
- torch
- bright flares
- map
- gun
- dried food and water
- a tiny stuff bag
- sticky duct tape
- a mini stove
- warm and cosy clothes

Instructions:
